Attendance Updates

As mentioned in previous Jumbunna editions this year, our school is collectively working closely with our families to improve our students' attendance in 2025. You may have noticed that if your child is listed as being absent from school without an explanation, our office team will contact families to ensure everything is ok.

The 2025 attendance goal is to have 80% or more students with less than 20 days absent from school.

Going to school every day is an important part of your child's education. Children and young people learn new things at school every day, connect with friends, have fun and develop good habits that help them to succeed after school. Attending and participating in school will help your child:

- develop important skills and knowledge to help them learn
- a develop social and emotional skills such as good communication, resilience and team work
- establish friendships with peers which help develop self-esteem and a sense of belonging.

There is no safe number of days for missing school. Being away from school for 1 day a fortnight adds up to missing 4 whole weeks of school a year. Where possible, you should avoid your child missing school, for example, make appointments for your child outside of school hours and keep family holidays to outside term time.

Road Safety

We have had a number of families contact the school with concerns around road safety of some of our adults picking up and dropping off their children. The last thing anyone wants is to endanger our children. The below is a snippet from the Mornington Peninsula Shire website around the programs in place to ensure the safety of all on our roads.





Road Safety around Schools - The Kiss & Go program is designed to provide families with a safe and convenient area for dropping off and picking up children from school. It's a short-term stopping area for children to be able to walk between the car and the school, using the safety of the footpath. Park and Stride, along with remote drop-off locations also serve to reduce congestions around schools.
