Uniform

As the cooler weather has arrived, we have noticed that some students are not meeting all the requirements of our Student Dress Code Policy.

A few reminders are listed below:

- There is to be no jewellery other than watches and simple earrings (stud or sleepers). The only exception is for a necklace that is worn for religious purposes. We are having lots of children wearing necklaces and it is a safety concern if they become caught on playground equipment etc (this is not new to the policy, but we are requesting that this is monitored from home)
- Hair beyond shoulder length should be tied back again this is for health (head lice) and safety (hair caught on playground etc) reasons.
- Clear nail polish is the only acceptable cosmetic.
- Local sports club attire is not school uniform and are not to be worn. All acceptable items are pictured in the full policy.
- Hemlines of shorts/skorts, skirts and dresses must be mid-thigh in length or longer.
- Bike shorts / skins are not acceptable as an outer garment and can only be worn underneath shorts/skorts and dresses and not visible.
- School beanies, hats and hoods are only for outdoor wear they are not acceptable as indoor attire.

We do know that there may be times where an item of uniform may not be available to be worn for a variety of reasons e.g. as it is wet after washing etc, but a message via compass to the classroom teacher or a physical note will be required.
