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### Week 10 – Principal Update

#### 🚧 Slow Down for Our Kids – 40km/h School Zones in Action! 🚧

This one is directed to the parents and carers this week and looking at the safety of our students.

During the week we have had a few reminders from families via email about concerns about road safety. We remind all drivers that **40km/h speed limits apply around schools during designated times** – typically between **8:00 – 9:30am and 2:30 – 4:00pm on school days**.

These reduced speed limits are not just rules – they are **lifesaving measures**. Children are unpredictable. They may cross the road suddenly or become distracted. Lower speeds give drivers more time to react and help prevent serious accidents.

- ✅ Look for the signs
- ✅ Stick to 40km/h
- ✅ Be alert for crossing supervisors and students
- ✅ Avoid distractions behind the wheel

Together, we can create a safer environment for every child. Whether you're dropping off, picking up, or just passing through – please **slow down and stay alert**.

### Semester 1 Reporting

Our teachers have been busy behind the scenes preparing Semester 1 reports for students. Reports will be uploaded to Compass in Week 11 for families to access.

Please ensure that you can log in to COMPASS to access these reports. Student reports are snapshots of each student's learning at this time, based on evidence from a range of assessments. These include work samples, NAPLAN, teacher designed assessments, observations, discussions, notes and feedback from students.

The reports do not stand on their own, they are an important element of our reporting and communication practices. Teachers, parents and students all share responsibility for learning. It is, therefore, important that you discuss the report with your child and plan what you will work on together.

Please remember these reports are based on the first 6 months of learning in 2025. Remember student's do not progress on a continual plane, they may plateau and grow at different speeds. If anything in the report needs clarification, please do not hesitate to make a booking with your child's teacher via the COMPASS portal for discussion during Parent Teacher Interviews in Week One of Term Three.

### Parent Teacher Interviews

Today you would have received a notice from Compass saying we have opened up Term 3 Parent Teacher Interview for Week 1 of Term 3. These meetings will occur on the following dates,

 Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 3:40pm - 6:30pm

Please select a time that suits you. The meetings will last for approximately 10 minutes. During this time, your child's teacher will discuss their semester report, current learning progress, and work with you to create learning goals for the next semester.

These meetings are a great opportunity to discuss the educational progress and wellbeing needs of our students. Students are not required at these meetings. This is a wonderful opportunity to work with your child's teacher to develop a strong and cohesive partnership for learning. We strongly suggest all families book an appointment with their child's classroom teacher and then, if needed, book an appointment with a specialist teacher or intervention teacher.
