5Rs

Last term our school completed our mandated school review. A School Strategic Plan is a 4-year plan for school improvement, completed by schools after their school review. The plan is based on the key directions recommended by the school review panel and an analysis of school performance data and evidence conducted during the review.

The School Strategic Plan:

- outlines the school's vision and values
- sets goals and targets for improved student outcomes
- lists the key improvement strategies that will help achieve these goals and targets
- is sensitive to local needs

One of the recommendations from our review was to work on some low-level behaviours (for example calling out) that were impacting teaching and learning at Somie Rise. After much work and discussion with students and teachers we have developed the Somie Rise 5Rs.

Please have a look over the process and discuss with your family on how we can all work together to improve teaching and learning.



We support positive, inclusive behaviours at Somie Rise!

These steps increase positive and respectful relationships between students and staff, while creating consistent predictable routines to ensure calm, safe and supportive learning environments.



Remind

A reminder of the expected behaviour will be provided, and you will be asked to adjust your behaviour.



Redirect

Two options will be provided to reset your behaviour. You will be asked to choose one of the options and demonstrate the expected behaviours.

You will be moved to another location within your learning space.



Remove

You will be removed from the learning space determined by the classroom teacher.



Restore

After the reflection sheet has been completed, a restorative conversation with your teacher will take place and your parents will be contacted.
